

We wish to thank all students and sponsors for their continued co-operation and support for Daystar University during the semester that ended on May 2010. Most sponsors and parents have tried as much as possible to honour their payment pledges. To God we give thanks and glory for this. In this communication we present to you the fees structure for the August semester 2010. Although the University has been affected by the changes in the economy in regard to price increases; it has not made any adjustments in tuition fees.

**1. Please note the following:**

- a). The total tuition fees per semester for Undergraduate students at Athi River campus assumes 16 credit hours at **Kshs. 5,381.00** per credit hour.
- b). The tuition fees for Undergraduate students at Nairobi Campus assumes 16 credit hours at **Kshs. 6,106.00** per credit hour.
- c). The tuition fees for Diploma students assumes 15 credit hours per semester at **Kshs. 4,856.00** per credit hour.
- d). Undergraduate tuition fees for students at Mombasa Campus assumes 16 credit hours at **Kshs. 5, 125** per credit hour, and 12 credit hours for Postgraduates at **Kshs. 7,100** per credit hour.
- e). Postgraduate programs assume 12 credit hours per semester at **Kshs. 7,875.00** per credit hour for continuing students who joined before August 2008, and **Kshs. 7,455.00** for students who joined from August 2008.

- f). The tuition fees for Pre-university are fixed at **Kshs. 63,000.00**.
- g). Cafeteria fees is **Kshs. 29,988.00** per semester.
- h). The University has Self Catering Units, which are charged at **Kshs. 15,855.00**, while Daystar University Parents Association (DUPA) self catering hostel is charged at **Kshs. 21,000.00** per semester.
- i). The transport charges from Nairobi to Athi River Campus are **Kshs. 20,000.00** and Athi River town to the Campus is **Kshs. 10,000.00**, per semester payable DIRECTLY to Kampala Coaches Company.
- j). The alumni registration, orientation fee and caution money are payable only once.
- k). Graduation fee is **Kshs. 7,000.00**.

*Note: Catering, hostel and transport costs are optional.*

*Please Note: Medical fees and cafeteria charges may vary depending on the agreement with the respective service providers. ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE A COMPREHENSIVE MEDICAL COVER.*

**INSTALLMENT PAYMENT PLAN**

Sponsors who intend to pay their fees by installment should sign installment agreement forms with Credit Controller in finance department under the following terms:

- i. At least 25% of tuition and hostel fees are payable at registration and the balance in 3 equal monthly installments.
- ii. All other fees or charges are payable at registration.
- iii. All installments should be paid on their due dates: fees should be paid in full before the onset of examinations.
- iv. Students who default on their installments will not be allowed to access services in future.
- v. No student will be allowed to sit for examinations without payment of full fees. An installment fee of **Kshs. 2,000.00** is charged to those who pay fees in installments.
