ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A minimum Mean Grade of **C+ (plus)** in KCSE or its equivalent with a minimum grade of B (Plain) in English or Kiswahili; OR a minimum of three **(3)** Principals in Advanced Level (A-Level); OR a Diploma in Law with a minimum of Credit Pass OR a degree in any other field from an accredited institution; OR any other qualification by the Kenya National Examinations Council or the Council of Legal Education equivalent to any of the above.

Upon completion of the degree candidates will undergo a 3-month internship outside Kenya. Career prospects include: Company Secretary; State Counsel; Magistrate; Judge; Prosecutor; Parliamentary Counsel; County Legal Officer; Advocate; Legal Officer in private companies, Banking sector, Parastatals, International organizations, Civil society organizations, among others.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Certificate Programme: A KCSE mean grade of D+ (plus) or its equivalent.

Diploma Programme: A KCSE mean grade of C- (minus) with a certificate course from a recognized institution, or a mean grade of C plain or principal pass in 'A' levels or 4 credits in GCE, or their equivalent. A KCSE mean grade of C- (minus) without a certificate course will be considered for a terminal diploma.

Undergraduate Programme: A mean grade of C+ (plus) and above in KCSE or 5 Credits in IGCSE with 2 Principal passes in A level or Division 2 in GCE or 50% from other countries using percentages.

Postgraduate Programme: A Bachelors degree from an accredited university with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00, or

a degree awarded with First Class or an Upper Second Class Honours. A GPA of 2.5 or a Lower Second Class Honours or Higher Diploma with relevant 2 years experience may be considered if the degree or diploma is relevant to the field of study.

PhD in Clinical Psychology: requires a 3.00 (on a 4.00 system) grade point average (GPA) or its equivalent in Master of Arts or Master of Science (from a recognized University) in Clinical Psychology, Counseling Psychology or a closely related discipline (e.g Psychology, Marriage & Family Therapy, or Social Work). A GPA of 3.00 is equivalent to B in other Universities.

PhD in Communication: requires a Masters degree in Communication with a GPA of 3.00 with thesis or two published articles. A GPA of 3.00 is equivalent to B in other Universities.
