ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Diploma Programme: C (plain) in KCSE or a Principal Pass in A levels, or 4 credits in GCE, or their equivalent qualifications, or a C- in KCSE and a Certificate course from a recognized institution.

Undergraduate Programme: C+ (plus) and above in KCSE or, 5 Credits in IGCSE; or 2 Principal passes in 'A' level or Division 2 in GCE or 50% from other countries using percentages; or CPA (K) entry to commerce degree.

Postgraduate Programme: A Bachelors degree from an accredited university with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00, or a degree awarded with First Class or an Upper Second Class Honours. A GPA of 2.5 or a Lower Second Class Honours or Higher Diploma with relevant 2 years experience may be considered if the degree or diploma is relevant to the field of study.
