PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The PhD is a 3-year comprehensive evening programme comprising a total of 86 credit hours as follows: 8 General Integration, 15 Research & Analysis, 18 Core Psychology, 9 Psychological Assessment tests including report writing, conceptualization and diagnosis, 12 Practicum, 18 Doctoral Dissertation and 6 Final Internship.

The PhD programme at Daystar University is taught by both regional and international faculty drawn from various Psychology fields such as Psychoanalysis, Psychodynamic Approach, Cognitive-Behavioral, Clinical and Experimental research, Neuropsychology, among other relevant specializations.
