

DR. JUSTUS MURIITHI MATHENGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION YEAR 2021/2022

This scholarship was proposed by Dr. Lilian Muriithi-Ollows (PhD, MBA, BCom), the daughter of a Daystar graduate the late Dr. Justus Muriithi Mathenge who graduated posthumously in year 2019 with a PhD in Clinical Psychology. Dr. Lilian's intention is to honor her father with this scholarship.

The scholarship is designed to enhance the Clinical Psychology career. The scholarship is open to a Daystar University student pursuing **Master in Clinical Psychology (MCP)**. The scholarship is limited to one student per year who is assessed based on need and academic merit. The amount to be awarded is a **maximum of 50% of the tuition fee per student annually**.

Qualification for the scholarship depends on the information provided on the application form which will be evaluated by the Daystar University Financial Aid Committee. Kindly note that the successful applicant will be required to carry out work-study duties (10hrs per week).

Requirements for the Eligibility of the MCP Scholarship are:

- i) That the beneficiary would be a 1st year student of Masters in Clinical Psychology
- ii) Student must have met all the other Daystar University scholarship award criteria which are;
 - a) Demonstrate financial need
 - b) Exhibit a strong Christian character and commitment to serve Jesus Christ
 - c) Academic performance: Student must have attained (and maintain upon receiving the scholarship) a Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.00 and above or its equivalent.

Required/ Supporting documents

Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- a. Admission Letter to Daystar University
- b. Letter of recommendation from an academic referee
- c. A copy of your Undergraduate Official Transcripts and Certificate
- d. Kindly upload any supporting documents that are applicable to you. For example; Parent(s) / Guardian/ Sponsor Death Certificate(s), Copy of HELB form, Bursary, Medical Reports, etc.
