

PHASED REOPENING SCHEDULE

In response to the Ministry of Education advisory to universities and colleges dated September 29, 2020, Daystar University announces phased re-opening as follows

Category	Period	Description
Online Semester for off-campus	August 31 – December 19, 2020	All students registered for August 2020 Semester will continue with their studies online. Online students are free to access our physical library in either campuses while their classes remain online. The Online Fees Structure with 15% discount on Tuition shall apply.
Special Block Semester	October 15 – December 19, 2020	This is a special semester for continuing students and first years who had deferred to January 2021 owing to challenges associated with online classes. Orientation for First Year students will take place on October 15-16, 2020. All students on the special physical semester shall register for a maximum of 9-12 credit hours or 3-4 courses. Each course shall meet twice per week on campus as scheduled.
