

## FEE STRUCTURE FOR AUGUST 2020 – JULY 2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

We thank all students, parents and guardians for your co-operation and support during the 2019-2020 academic year.

In this communication, we present to you the 2020-2021 Fee Structure. While changes have taken place in the wider economy with regard to inflation, the University has made a decision not to adjust tuition fees.

- 1) Tuition charge per credit hour will thus remain as follows:
- a) Undergraduate programmes: The total tuition fees per semester assumes 15 credit hours for students on both campuses. A credit hour at Main Campus Athi River costs Kshs 5,650 while at Nairobi Campus it costs Kshs 6,410.
- **b) Nursing programme:** Tuition fees is fixed at Kshs 80,715 per semester.
- c) Law programme: Tuition fees assumes a full load of 18 credit hours per semester at Kshs 6,950 per credit hour.
- d) Master's degree programs: At Nairobi Campus, tuition fees assume a full load of 9 credit hours per semester at Kshs 7,830 per credit hour.
- **e) PhD programmes:** At Nairobi Campus, tuition fees assumes 9 credit hours per semester at Kshs 15,000 per credit hour.
- f) Postgraduate Diploma programmes: Tuition fees assumes 12 credit hours per semester at Kshs 4,000 per credit hour.
- g) Diploma Programmes: Tuition fees for diploma programmes assumes a full load of 15 credit hours per semester. Diploma in Communication is charged at Kshs 5,100 per credit hour while other Diploma courses are charged at Kshs 3,000 per credit hour
- 2) Accommodation Plan: The University has boarding facilities for students studying at the Main Campus Athi-River. The semester accommodation charges are as follows: -

- a) Full Board Hostel & Cafeteria Kshs 45,052 (Hostel 16,052 & Cafeteria 29,000)
- b) Self-catering Units Kshs 15,855
- c) DUPA Hostels Kshs 21,000
- 3) Medical Fee: All fulltime students must have a comprehensive medical cover. The University has negotiated a Medical Insurance Cover chargeable at Kshs 17,500 per academic year. Students who are already medically covered are exempted from paying the medical fees on condition that one produces a letter in the first month of the semester as proof of a valid medical insurance.
- 4) Transport Charges: Transport charges for Dayscholar students are as follows:
- a) Return trip from Nairobi to Main Campus Athi River is Kshs 20,000 per semester.
- b) Return trip from Athi River town to Main Campus Athi River is Kshs 12,000 per semester.

**Please note:** Catering, Hostel and Transport costs are optional. Medical fees and Cafeteria charges may vary depending on the agreement with the respective service providers.

## 5) Other one-time charges:-

- a) Graduation fee of Kshs 8,500 is charged when a student falls due to graduate.
- b) Additional Orientation Fee of Kshs 500 is charged to new foreign students.
