On entry the student is issued with a visitor's pass valid for three months at a fee. The visitor's visa is used to apply for Student Visa i.e. Kenya Pupils Pass (KPP). It is against the Kenyan law for an international student to study without a valid visa.





Student Visa otherwise known as Kenya Pupils Pass(KPP) is a legal document that allows foreign students to study in Kenya. The immigration Act Cap 172 of the laws of Kenya provides for issuance of this to applicants (foreign students) who wish to pursue their education in Kenya's education or training institutions.





The officer is expected to:-



- Write introduction letter to the immigration for each individual student.
- Guide each student on application procedure
- Ensure that attachments required are submitted
- Submit KPP applications to immigration offices at Nyayo house.
- Collect approvals
- Facilitate the student to pay for their approved KPPs.
- Have the KPPs endorsed on students' Passport

Note: The student's responsibility is key in making sure that they have a valid study visa throughout the study period.



Accommodation and fees

- On campus accommodation is available to all International full time students wishing to reside at the Main Campus for the duration of their course. We encourage all International students to live on-campus for safety purposes.
- To provide students with certainty in their financial planning, the University has no special school fees for international students. International students pay the same rate as Kenyan students.
